Hoping for a "varnish that has a great taste, smooth consistency, and applies evenly on the teeth," Donna Shewbert was happy that FluoroCal's "consistency isn't pasty and doesn't leave a thick residue." While Gugliotti's patients preferred Spearmint overall, both she and her patients "were excited to try Green Apple because the flavor is very different."
